

Hints and tips for **Businesses**

As we approach the Accessible Christmas lights and shopping evening Monday 3rd December 5:30-7:30pm

- 1. Check out Purple Tuesdays customer service guide on the website <u>www.purpletuesday.org.uk</u>
- 2. If you have a hearing loop, check it is working and staff know how to use it
- 3. Turn the music down
- 4. Place a chair or extra seating out if possible (please don't block wheelchair access)
- 5. Ensure accessible toilets are clear of other objects
- 6. Clear aisles of trip hazards
- 7. Check you have no flashing lights on (strobes) and if possible turn down very strong lights (there is a balance between sensory to light and visual impairment ask us at **places@access.gg** if you need guidance)
- 8. If you have undertaken the Hidden disabilities training ensure the window sticker is visible and staff are wearing their Here to help badge (email <u>hello@accessibletown.gg</u> for more if needed)
- 9. Update all staff working on the night of the Shopping Evening and a few top tips around its use
- 10. If you have a removal ramp ensure it is close by and staff know how to use it
- 11. If possible, provide paper towels rather than the electric hand dryers (the noise can be distressing)
